

School Shop

A school shop is in operation at the school. All items pertaining to school uniform, snacks, drinks, light meals etc. are obtainable from the school shop. The school shop is open from Monday to Friday.

School Fees

St. Mark's School, in terms of section 39 of the schools act 84 of 1996, is entitled to change school fees as established by the Governing body unless specific application for Exemption is made. To avoid payment delays parents are advised to pay through a debit order obtainable from the accounts department.

School Finance Control

The Governing Body appoints a financial Sub Committee to control all funds collected in the name of the school. This committee draws up detailed budget in September of each year which is then rectified in the 4th Term. The finance Committee meets at least once a quarter to review the account and to consider other matters relating to the use of school funds.

Academics

Curriculum

Great emphasis is placed on a vigorous and disciplined approach to academic success.

The Curriculum is divided into four Phases;

1. Foundation Phase : Grade 1 - 3
2. Intermediate Phase : Grade 4 - 7
3. GET Phase : Grade 8 - 9

The academic programme is implemented by means of a 5-day cycle of 1 hour-long lessons in the Junior school.

4. FET Phase : Grade 10-12
- i) General Stream ii) Commercial Stream
- iii) Science Stream

Seven or eight subjects have to be taken per stream.

All Learners are expected to take English plus one other language. Mathematics or Mathematical Literacy and Life Orientation.


